- Grape Varietals:** Merlot with small amounts of Malbec and Petite Verdot
- Wine Making:** The grapes for this wine are donated from Red Heaven Vineyard Washington's prestigious Red Mountain AVA. Matured in barrel.
- Tasting Note:** A generous helping of cocoa, vanilla, ripe plum, pomegranate and bing cherry. Full mid-palate with supple tannins.
- Serving Suggestions:** Excellent paired with port tenderloin, grilled veal chops, lamb shoulder or roast duck. Perfect for warming up during the cold, wet Pacific NW winter.
- Fun Facts:** Red Mountain's terrain is the result of the Missoula floods of the last Ice Age, when the then-sizable Lake Missoula in Montana burst its glacial dam sending a wall of water through eastern Washington. The resulting soils on Red Mountain limit vigor and yield producing concentrated flavors in small grapes.
