Grape Varietals: Malbec 50% and Petit Verdot 25% with and Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon

Wine Making: 125 cases made from a special selection of fruit from the Doc Steward and Red Heaven Vineyards.

Tasting Note: Dark ruby in color. Violet and plum on the nose followed by ripe plum, tobacco and cedar on nose and palate with moderate tannins to create this well structured Reserve wine.

Serving Suggestions: A natural fit for grilled steak, veal, lamb or sausage. A nice pairing with hard cheeses as well.

Fun Facts: Malbec is originally from France. Today, the majority of France's Malbec is in the Cahors region. It is still used as a blending partner to Cabernet, Merlot and Petite Verdot in Bordeaux. However, it has never become a top French variety due to its poor resistance to cold, wet weather. Instead, it found a new home in Argentina and here in Washington.
